On reference to your letter of the 18th ultimo respecting the sailing ship "**COLBERT**", I have to state that she has been in dry dock at Saint-Nazaire for some time and expects to undock in a few days.

I sent a telegram to the Owner, Baron de Forest, who replied that the vessel had been sold. On making enquiries at the Chantiers de la Loire, it appears that the Polish Government have bought this vessel, but I have not been able to find their representative at Saint-Nazaire.

No work to my knowledge has been done in the dry dock, only cleaning and painting.
