I have to acquaint you that the Committee have to-day had before them a letter, dated 16th ultimo, received from the Society's Surveyor at Cleveland, enclosing one from the Independent Steamship Co., of that city, intimating that the Steamers "CHIPPEWA", "KIOWA" and "CAYUGA" have been sold as follows, viz:-

Steamer "CHIPPEWA"	- Pioneer Steamship Co. of Cleveland
"KIOWA"	- Kiowa Transportation Co. of Bay
"CAYUGA"	- Cayuga Transportation Co. " City.

The Independent Steamship Company conclude their letter by asking that the classification of these vessels should be withdrawn from the Register Book, but before taking any action in the matter, the Committee would be glad if you would kindly ascertain the intentions of the new Owners in regard to the classification of each vessel.
