At the end of September the Society's Surveyor at Cleveland, Ohio, wrote that the steamers "CAYUGA", "CHIPPEWA", "MONTFAUCON" and "ONONDAGA", belonging to the Independent S.S. Co. Inc. were employed on the Great Lakes, and he was informed that the arrangement approved by the General Committee of this Society in 1920, remains in force as regards these four vessels, viz:-

"In view of the fact that these vessels are only in "service for a few months each year and are always in "fresh water, the shafts to be examined by the Society's "Surveyors when drawn in on account of damage, but no "definite ruling to be made in regard to the same".

A letter has now come to hand from the Cleveland Surveyor in which he states that the steamer "KIOWA", belonging to the above Company, is also employed on the Great Lakes.

It is submitted that the same course be followed as in the case of the "Cayuga", "Chippewa" etc.
