The Kobe Surveyors report this ship placed in dry dock and the requirements of the 1st S.S.No.1, due 12,35, complied with.

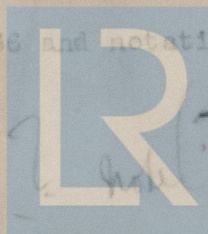
The bottom has been cleaned and coated and minor repairs effected.

The vessel has now been made into a passenger ship which includes the fitting of a new watertight bulkhead on frame 78 and other alterations carried out in accordance with approved plans.
