This case received the consideration of the Committee on the 18th instant, when action was deferred as the Dunkirk Surveyor wrote that he had arranged to commence the Boiler Survey but that subsequently the Owners desired to postpone the inspection until further notice in view of the fact that the vessel was not due to sail from Dunkirk until the early part of January next.


The Dunkirk Surveyor now writes forwarding a letter from the Owners intimating that from the present date the "BOUSSOLE" and "ASTROLABE" are being transferred to the Bureau Veritas. The Surveyor adds:-




that the "ESPERANCE" & "RECHERCHE" of the same Owners were transferred to the Bureau Veritas practically as soon as they were due for Special Survey, and as the New Convention Freeboard Surveys are now obligatory in France, the Owners have most probably decided to anticipate matters in the present instance."

Submitted that in the circumstances the class of this vessel be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots inserted in lieu, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
