I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter Ref. "H" of the 18th instant relative to the Boiler Survey of the Steamer "BOUSSOLE"

Without, however, having communicated with the Cie des Messageries Maritimes on the subject, I have to-day received a letter notifying that from the present date the "ASTROLABE" & "BOUSSOLE" are being transferred to the Bureau Veritas.

For your guidance I enclose herewith the original letter together with free translation.

In this connection it will doubtless be remembered that the "ESPERANCE" & "RECHERCHE" of the same Owners were transferred to the Bureau Veritas practically as soon as they were due for Special Survey, and as the New Convention Freeboard Surveys are now obligatory in France, the Owners have most probably decided to anticipate matters in the present instance.
