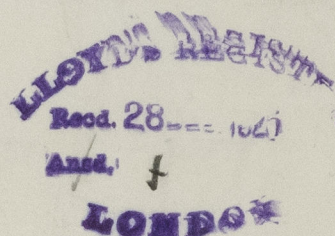

This vessel is now in this district and has, I understand, been surveyed by the local Society with a view to classification with the Teikoku Kaiji Kyokai.

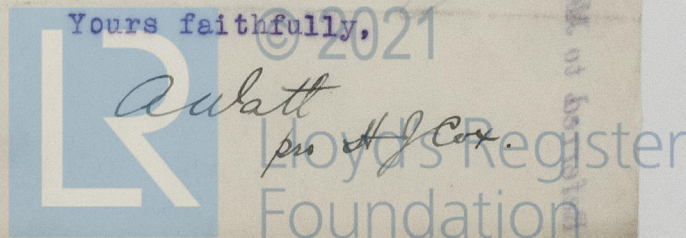
The Boilers became due for survey last month (November), and have not been submitted for our survey. Upon enquiry, the Owners inform us that they do not wish to retain our classification.
