With reference to the Glasgow First Entry Report No. 39275 on the S.S. "LONDONIER", I have to say that it is concluded the thickness of bridge deck plating is as approved, that the thickness of bulkhead plating and stiffeners are in accordance with an approved plan, and also that the record of "Cem" should be made in this case, and not "pt. cem" as in previous Standard Vessels, but I shall be glad if you will kindly ascertain from the Surveyors and let me know whether this is so.
