I have compared the arrangements on board the ship with those given in the original freeboard report and I have found them to be in agreement therewith or equivalent thereto, and the whole to be in efficient condition.

*Vessel examined in dry dock & Special Survey 2<sup>nd</sup> NOT completed. Hatchways, Hatches, Battening down arrangements, Ventilators, air pipes, Machinery openings &c all examined. A few Hatch covers & battening down bars renewed, some canvas covers for Ventilator Comings &c renewed & a few door fastenings to overhaul & these are in hand.*

The freeboard marking has been verified and found to agree with the freeboards given on certificate No. ✓ dated 24<sup>th</sup> April 1933 which is ~~returned herewith~~ will be returned when the new certificates are handed over.
