I have compared the arrangements on board the ship with those given in the original freeboard report and I have found them to be in agreement therewith or equivalent thereto, and the whole to be in efficient condition.

Vessel examined in dry dock & Special Survey 2nd NOT completed. Hatchways, Hatches, Battering down arrangements, Ventilators, air pipes, Machinery openings &c all examined. A few Hatch covers & Battering down bars renewed, some Canvas covers for Ventilator Comings &c renewed & a few door fastenings to overhaul & these are in hand.

The freeboard marking has been verified and found to agree with the freeboards given on certificate No. ✓ dated 24th April 1933 which is returned herewith. will be returned when the new certificates are handed over.
