
I have to send herewith for your information and guidance a translation of a letter which has today been received from the Registro Italiano, Genoa, respecting the steamer "PEARLSTONE", now at your port, and shall be glad if you will give the case the necessary attention.

This case should be dealt with similarly to that of the "LUCIANO", ex "Maronian", surveyed at your port in June last. Before undertaking the survey you should satisfy your-selves that the sale of the vessel has been definitely completed.

A fee of £10/10-0 should be charged for the issue of the provisional certificate on behalf of the Registro Italiano, the whole of which amount should be credited to Lloyd's Register.

I enclose a small supply of the R.I. forms, and you should forward the provisional certificate, together with your Reports 8 & 9, to this Office in duplicate.

At the same time I have to request that you will carry out an Annual Loadline Survey in this case, and issue
