Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 19th instant respecting the steamer "PEARLSTONE", from which it is noted that the vessel is now on her way to Barbados and that you desire to postpone the completion of the Special Survey No.3 and Boiler Survey until the end of next month, when it is anticipated she will have returned to this side.

The Committee have had the case before them at their meeting today, and I have to say that in the circumstances they will not object to the further postponement desired in this instance, provided the survey be completed on the vessel's return to this side, as now stated.

At the same time I would remind you that the freeboard certificate expires on the 11th January next, and it is concluded that the renewal survey will be carried out at the same time as the completion of the Special Survey.
