Dear Sirs,

I have to acquaint you that the Convention freeboard survey of the steamer "ZAPALA" was carried out at Cardiff in June last and certificates issued valid until the end of September next.

It is understood from the Owners that this vessel is at present undergoing Special Survey No.2 at your port, and they desire to be furnished with a new Loadline certificate valid for five years from the date of the completion of this survey.

In the circumstances, I shall be glad if you will verify the freeboard markings and forward to this Office a verification of marking form C 12(a), together with a note that no alteration has taken place as regards the closing appliances indicated on the certificate.


I may add that you should charge a fee of £4 for your survey in this instance, in accordance with the Board of Trade scale.
