We beg to inform you that it is understood from the local Customs Authorities that the above vessel has now been taken over by the Admiralty and her official registry closed as from the 19th instant.

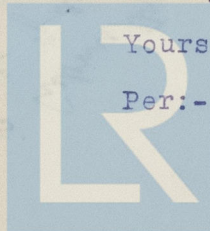
The Load Line Certificate enclosed herewith has been forwarded to us by the Customs who state they do not know the whereabouts of the certified copy.
