Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines  
in

1 port 1 starba. opening now made in forecastle end bulkhead.  
openings 4'-0" x 2'-6" sills 15" high with hinged steel W.T. doors  
secured by clip handles operated both sides.

A Hatchway 3'-4" x 3'-4" has previously been fitted on the  
freight deck over the after peak. Coaming 18" high x .40" thick.  
Hinged steel W.T. cover secured by hinged bolts + nuts.

A hatchway 1'-8" x 2'-0" has previously been fitted on  
superstructure deck over ammunition locker abreast engine  
room skylight, starba. side. Coaming 18" high. Hinged steel  
W.T. cover secured by hinged bolts + nuts. One 6" dia.  
mushroom ventilator having screw-down top fitted on top of  
hatch cover.
