

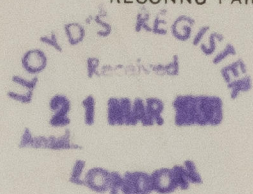

Referring to the 2nd paragraph of your letter we presume it is intended that reports should be made on forms Rpt C.II or Rpt C.II (Comp) depending on whether any alterations have been made but we shall be glad if you will be good enough to confirm and also to forward a further supply of the forms in question.
