s. I am in receipt of Mr. Allan's letter of the 5th instant, enclosing one from Mr. C.H. Pile respecting the steamer No. 347 built by Messrs. Short Bros., Ltd., and in reply I have to state that provided the vessel be surveyed when in dry dock or on the slip with a view to an amended date of final survey being recorded in the Register Book the Owner's request that the date of build may be recorded as six months after the date of launch, as provided for in the Rules, will be agreed to.


