In reply to your classing letter of the 6th of August respecting the s.s. "FOREMOST 36", Rotterdam Report No. 15418, I beg to inform you that the smallest distance between boiler and uptakes and bunkers and woodwork is over 30". Safety valves adjusted to 180 lbs. and fitted with easing gear; three bilge suctions and a direct suction is fitted in the engine room as shown on the approved plan, but same has been omitted to be stated in the reports.
