"Marinula" ex "Santa Margherita"* and marked as below, ~~have been surveyed during construction~~ by the undersigned. ~~The material has been tested by the Surveyors to Lloyd's Register;~~ the scantlings are in accordance with the Society's Rules for a working pressure of *100* lbs. per square inch, and the workmanship is good. The Boilers having been tested in my presence on the *3<sup>rd</sup> February 1920* by hydraulic pressure to *200* lbs. per square inch, showed no signs of weakness, and were found tight and sound in every respect at that pressure. Working pressure not to exceed *one hundred* ← lbs. per square inch.
