With reference to your letter of the 5th instant respecting the Motor Vessel "INDORITA" I beg to acquaint you that the vessel was taken over by the Owners before the additional side keelson referred to in the Secretary's letter of 28th February 1921 could be fitted, but the Builders are making arrangements to fit it at the earliest opportunity, while the vessel is laid up in the River Dee and is not likely to be placed in commission for some months.

I may add however that this keelson has been fitted in the case of the sister vessel "ELDORITA" now completing at Mansferry.
