The class is subject to the sternframe E.W. 11,40 being specially examined at the next dry docking, and to a bower anchor and 30 fathoms of chain cable being supplied at the earliest opportunity.

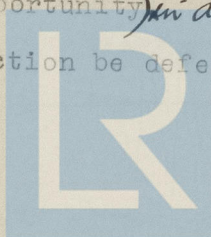
The BRISBANE Surveyor reports (3,42) the vessel examined afloat on account of collision and by a diver ~~no~~ found.

The Surveyor, however, recommends the vessel be further examined (at the first opportunity) ~~in dry dock~~.
