## ANSWER.

I have to acquaint you that in April last the Committee agreed to the Owners' proposal to carry out a General Examination at Amsterdam and to undertake the overdue Special Survey on the vessel's arrival in Greece, subject to this arrangement being definitely adhered to.

The requisite General Examination was carried out at Amsterdam in April last, when the Screwshaft Survey was held and the Boiler Survey commenced. The Surveyors stated you were duly advised regarding the case and in the circumstances I shall be glad to learn how the matter now stands.
