
Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 23rd January regarding the equipment of the s.s. "LYNGAAS". The marks on the anchors given by you have been referred to the Sunderland Proving House, who have issued the enclosed duplicate certificates.

On looking into the matter of the minimum weight required for a third anchor, it has been ascertained that this should be 10 cwts. and the remainder of the equipment should be in accordance with letter "h".

As the markings are indecipherable on the chain cables, originally tested at Netherton, it will not be possible, of course, to issue duplicate certificates. If these are required a retest will have to be carried out.


