I beg to inform you that the following marks have been found on the two bower anchors of the above vessel:

Port. L.P.H.-S, 45257, 18.43, 15.16.3.14. B.T.

Starboard L.P.H.-S, 45255 18.43. 15.19.07. B.T.

and the owners request to be furnished with new anchor certificates as no certificates were on board when the vessel was taken over from the Admiralty.

The weight of anchors could not be ascertained. At the same time I shall be glad to be informed of the minimum weight required for the 3rd anchor.

The chain cables have also been examined and found to be tested at Lloyd's Proving House, Netherton, but markings indecipherable.
