Dear Sir,

I have had a visit from a Señor Hernan Ossa, who advises me that he has bought the steamer "Don Luis" from the Lota Company, becoming the legal owner on the 19th of this month.

Through being in communication with his insurance broker in London he learns that this ship's class is to lapse at the end of the present month. I assured him that the class would automatically be expunged for not effecting the recommended repairs in the time stated, but agreed to present his case to the Committee.

Sr. Ossa desires the Society's class for his vessel. He states, however, that he is committed to making two voyages to Buenos Aires before being able to effect any repairs, the vessel having already left on the first of these voyages. He says he would be in a position to carry out the extensive repairs by the end of October next.

I should be pleased to learn the Committee's reaction to this case as soon as possible so that I can acquaint the Owner of his position.

It might be added that the "Don Benjamin Squella" is still under repair here but should be completed in less than one week's time.

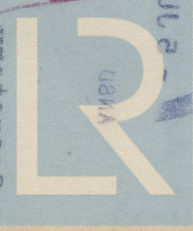
