Dear Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 15th instant enclosing Freeboard Certificates in the case of the steamer "CAPE VERDE", we beg to acquaint you that the conditions of assignment have been completed as below and the certificates handed over.

1. All the ventilator coamings on the poop are now efficiently supported.
2. Efficient means have been provided for closing the openings of all the air pipes.
3. Suitable provision has been made for rigging lifelines available for use in any part of the ship which might have to be used by the crew in the regular working of the ship.
4. Doors and locks on the machinery casings have been made efficient.
5. Renewals and part repairs have been effected to the steel covers on the fidley gratings, port ventilator coaming to the stokehold and to the mushroom hops of the 6" ventilators on the poop deck.

Two copies of an old Freeboard certificate dated 11th February 1928 are enclosed for cancellation.
