S.S. "CAPE VERDE".

This steamer, now at Liverpool, is intended to move to Langton Graving Dock tomorrow night for hull cleaning and painting, and to undock twentyfour hours later. It seems to us that occasion should be taken now for necessary <sup>preliminary</sup> steps being moved with a view to the freeboard being dealt with under the convention. The vessel's voyage is likely to be something like four or six months, and on her return from same we presume arrangements could then be made for carrying through the actual change of loadline, etc.

We have mentioned the matter to your Glasgow Secretary today, and our object in writing is ~~so~~ that you may give necessary instructions tomorrow if you consider it necessary or advisable to do so.
