Referring to your letter of the 1st instant regarding Bremen Report No.1324 on the oil engine machinery M.A.N. No.330570, which has been fitted at Kobe on board the motorship "KIRISHIMA MARU", I beg to enclose a forging report from the Düsseldorf Surveyors referring to the thrust shaft which is stamped:—"LLOYD'S No.1984 F.K. 6.8.30", from which it appears that the diameter of this shaft in a rough turned condition was 436 mm. It is further stated by the Augsburg Surveyor that the thrust shaft was not sent to Augsburg, but that Messrs. Maschinenfabrik Augsburg-Mürnberg A.G. are giving the diameter of the thrust shaft in a finished condition with 430 mm.
