Remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/6/92.)

The class is subject to the solepiece of the sternframe E.W. 7,34 and reinforced 12,37 and further welded 10,38 and the sternframe E.W. 5,35,9,37 and 12,37 being specially examined at the next dry docking and to the bottom being specially examined in dry dock and necessary repairs made on termination of present voyage to Genoa(after heavy weather).

X The Genoa Surveyor now report the vessel placed in dry dock, bottom coated and on account of damage during heavy weather as above, bottom plating and floors dealt with and repairs to bilge keel etc., carried out.

On account of wear and tear a keel shoe plate fitted and minor repairs effected.

Some additional strengthening has been fitted to the bottom forward including the ^{addition} fitting of half height intercostal girders in No.1 double bottom tank in accordance with sketch in report; further additional strengthening has been fitted to the double bottom tank top in the form of angle stiffeners in line with floors(see sketch).

This strengthening is stated to have been carried out on account of the vessel pounding heavily when in a light condition.

The E.W. repairs as above, examined and found efficient.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 3,40, subject as above, except as regards examination of bottom in dry dock and necessary heavy weather repairs.
