Dear Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 25th October last forwarding copies of report and load line certificate issued by you in the case of the Italian tanker "FULGOR", I have to acquaint you that a letter has now been received from Mr. J.R. Smith, the Society's Technical Representative for the Western Mediterranean, intimating that the Italian Owners have decided to reclass the vessel with the Registro Italiano only and have dropped their original intention to reclass the vessel with the Society for the present.

It was mentioned in one of the letters that you had carried out Engine, Boiler and Drydocking Surveys as 'R.I. Surveyor' and that the Italian Owners were not prepared at this time to re-open these parts to obtain reclassification with Lloyd's Register.

I have written to Mr. J.R. Smith as per copy of letter enclosed and shall be glad to receive any comments you may have to make from your end.
