I duly received Mr. Bartlett's letter of the 11th instant in further reference to the defective rivets in the S.S.No.1 ("FULGOR") now being completed by the Cantieri Navali della Spezia, together with the sample rivet advised therein, and have to inform you that the contents have been very carefully noted.

In reply thereto I am directed to state that in forwarding your First Entry Report on the vessel ^{you} should refer to this correspondence and state if any further examination has taken place in dry dock, and if so, the number of rivets renewed.

At the same time I have to state that in any case the vessel cannot be recommended for classification without condition unless the riveting is in order.

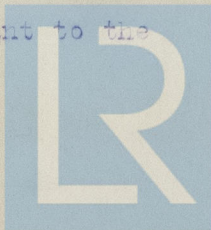
