 this date.


I have compared the arrangements on board the ship with
 the requirements of the Convention ~~as given in the original freeboard report~~ and I have found them to be
reasonably
 agreement therewith or equivalent thereto, and the whole to be in efficient
 dition.

The vessel has been examined in dry dock at this time and
 whole of the requirements for the 2nd Special Survey No. 2 have
 been carried out.

The hatchways, coamings, hatches, wire lashings tarpauline
 fittings have been specially examined, and now placed in good
 order.

The freeboard marking has been verified and found to agree
 the freeboards given on certificate No. 3133 dated 3rd December, 1932.
Form L.L.2 (N.2).
 which is returned herewith.

The present Freeboard Certificate expires on the 28th February,
 and the Owners desire a new Certificate to be issued in the
 ship's new name, port of Registry and under Chinese Nationality.
