Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your telegram of today's date respecting the Steel Screw Steamer No. 225 proposed to be built by you as follows, viz:-

"No. 225 freeboard we counted on two feet six inches from top of beam what would you suggest to attain this".

With regard thereto I have to acquaint you that the freeboard provisionally assigned is the minimum admitted by the Regulations for the particulars and dimensions supplied.

If a reduced freeboard is desired with the same dimensions and co-efficient it will be necessary to increase the length of the deck erections, and the sheer and round of beam might also be increased.
