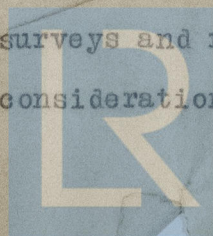

With reference to your letter of the 25th September last year respecting the classification in the Society's Register Book of your steam trawler "CHICAGO", I beg to acquaint you that the General Committee have had the case before them at their meeting to-day.

This vessel became due for the Special Survey No. 3 so long ago as March 1920, and as she continues to be laid up and no arrangements have been made for the inspection to take place, the Committee regret that they do not see how they can allow the class to remain any longer.

In these circumstances they have accordingly given instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Rules.

I have to add that upon the receipt of a satisfactory report from the Society's Surveyors on the completion of the necessary surveys and repairs, the case will receive the favourable consideration of the Committee
