In December last the Chicago Surveyors stated they had been informed by the Owners that the vessel was in Winter Quarters at Seattle.

In reply to enquiry the Seattle Surveyors wrote on the 23rd February they were informed by the Owners that it was not their intention to employ the vessel during 1921, but should they decide to do so they would give due notice so that the necessary surveys could be made.

In the circumstances the Committee, who had the case before them on the 15th ultimo, gave instructions that the Owners should be requested to furnish the usual undertaking.

The Owners now write:-

"Replying to your letter of the 16th March in regard to the steamer "CHICAGO" which is laid up indefinitely at Seattle, I beg to advise it is understood that before we put this boat into service again, it will be necessary to have a survey made".
