Dear Sirs,

With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of your steam trawler "CHICAGO", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had under their consideration a letter received from the Society's Surveyors at Seattle in which they state this vessel is at present laid up and that you will have the Special Survey No. 3, which became due at the end of March last, carried out should you decide to put her into service again.

In the circumstances the Committee desire me to inform you that they are agreeable to the Special Survey No. 3 being postponed for the present in the event of it not being convenient to you to complete the same at an early date, on the condition they usually require in the cases of vessels which are overdue for survey and are lying up indefinitely, viz:- that the survey be carried out before the vessel is again sent to sea, and that you undertake to have this done if she remain your property, and, should she be offered for sale, to inform intending purchasers that the class is allowed to remain subject to this being done, and to advise this Office of the name and address of the purchasers as soon as a sale is effected.

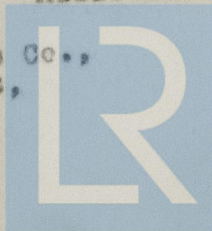
I shall therefore be glad to learn that you are willing to agree to this condition.
