

It is submitted that the Seattle Surveyor should be informed that the provision of Circular No 1071 to which he refers in his letter applies to the survey of old work only. In the last paragraph, however, of the circular he will find that the fee for the special survey of new vessels and machinery are to be divided equally between the Surveyors and the Society unless in any particular case good reasons are shown to the contrary.

If any portion of the £74 referred to in his letter was received by him in payment for services rendered by him as a private marine surveyor and not for services which the Society's Surveyors are required to render as such, then such portion should not be debited with a charge of 10 per cent to be remitted to this office. But all fees received by him for surveying the hulls and machinery of vessels built under his survey for classification should be divided equally between himself and the Society unless the Committee should see fit to favourably entertain an application to the contrary.
