The class is subject to the bilge keel at fore end, port side, being repaired at Owners' convenience and to the solepiece of the stern-frame, E.W. 9.39, being specially examined at the next dry docking.

The Trieste Surveyors report the vessel examined in dry dock, bottom coated, and minor repairs effected.


The bilge keel as above not dealt with, examined and found efficient.

The stern-frame as above examined and a small fracture in way of the welding rewelded electrically.

It is submitted this vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 4.40, subject as above.
