Special Survey (D) due at expiration of validity of "Examined" notation at the end of 12.47.

(Held on machinery). Last Special Survey held 1937.

Survey Due nt repairs required to shell plating starboard side aft. at Special Survey.

The case received consideration in July last, when, in view of the fact that no Special Survey has been held since 1937, the Committee was unable to agree to the Owners' proposal to postpone the Special Survey due until the end of the present year. The Committee were prepared however to agree to the Special Survey being postponed, subject to a satisfactory General Examination being held, on the understanding that the Special Survey requirements would be fully complied with not later than 1st. October.

On the 3rd September the Amsterdam Surveyor cabled stating that the Owners had requested a General Examination valid until the end of December if the Special Survey would be held, but the Committee declined to alter their previous decision.

In reply to enquiry the Helsingfors Surveyor now cables to the effect that this vessel is docking at Amsterdam on the 2nd November.
