COCHRAN BOILERS NOS 8395/6.

We are in receipt of your favour of the 12th inst, requesting us to let you have Drawing of the above boilers which have now been placed on board the Steamer "Adige" ex "War Epic". We herewith have pleasure in handing you Drawing No. 12205 for Boiler No. 8395, and Drawing No. 12206 for Boiler No. 8396. We shall be glad if you will let us know if these boilers are now under your Survey, so that we can note this information on our records.

With regard to your letter of 23rd Decr, confirming your telegram asking for drawing for Boilers 8426/7 which we have already sent you, we have looked further into the matter, and have to say that these drawings were sent as requested by you. We find no particulars as to which ship they were for. However from your letter of the 23rd, we see that the boilers are on board the steamer "Fiume" so that the drawings we sent you are not correct. The boiler Nos should be 8426/7, and we now take the liberty of sending you Working Drawing of these two boilers -

Drawing No. 12203 for Boiler No. 8426.  
" " No. 12204 for Boiler No. 8427.

Had we had the information that the boilers were for the S.S. "Fiume" at the time we received your wire, we would have sent you the correct drawings.
