Dear Sir,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 4th instant, respecting the boilers referred to in the Glasgow first entry report No. 38333 which have been fitted into the s.s. "FIUME" (ex "WAR GENIUS"), and note that they were built under specification survey up to the completion in the shops.

An account has to-day been rendered to the Ministry of Shipping for the fees due for the survey during construction of the machinery of this vessel, and, on payment, your account will be credited with £36: 10: 4 for the survey of the boilers during construction.

I shall therefore be glad if you will kindly see that the necessary entries are now made in the Glasgow Rough Fee and Debit Books in the usual way.
