I have received a reply from Messrs. Cochran this morning stating that copies of the plans were yesterday forwarded to Cardiff.

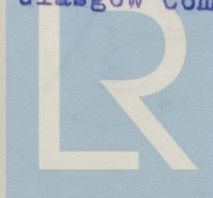
