Sir,

I am in receipt of your telegram of to-day's date reading as follows:-

"Steamer "FIUME" Boiler plans required are Cochran's 8426 and 8427, not 8246 and 8247 forwarded January last".

In connection with this matter I think it well to explain that on the 21st December last you asked to be supplied with the plans of Messrs. Cochran's Donkey Boilers Nos. 8246 and 8247 which had been fitted on board the "FIUME", ex "WAR GENIUS", and these plans were forwarded to you on the 24th of that month, and acknowledged in yours of the 29th.

On the 13th of January last Messrs. Cochran stated that the Boilers which had been fitted on board this vessel were Boilers Nos. 8426 and 8427, and plans of these Boilers were forwarded with my letter of the 14th of that month and acknowledged by you on the 18th.

If you should desire further copies of the plans of these Boilers I will endeavour to procure copies and send them to Cardiff as soon as possible.
