S. With reference to your letter of the 17th November last regarding the Motorship "MAYSPRING", I think it well to inform you that the assignment of class in both the above mentioned cases has been deferred pending the receipt of particulars of the torsional characteristics.

These have now been received and are found to be satisfactory.

Each vessel is eligible for a class of "100A1 With fbd., For Coasting Service between Anticosti Island & Demerara including the West Indies (Service North of 36°N in Summer Season only)", but as it is understood they have been sold to Danish Owners it is thought that this special service will no longer apply.

The reprint of the Register Book is in course of preparation here and it will be appreciated if you can furnish me with particulars of the new Owners and new names of these ships, together with the Owners' proposal in regard to the service in which the vessels are to be employed. If this information is received in time it will be inserted in the new Register Book, otherwise we shall have to record the Canadian names and service, and I shall be obliged if you will let me know the position as soon as possible.
