Dear Sirs,

S. I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 23rd instant enclosing an application for re-classification of the steam trawler "EVELYN", and to say that in order to render this vessel eligible for re-classification it will be necessary for the full requirements of the Second Special Survey No.3, including the drilling of the shell plating, to be carried out and the vessel placed in a thoroughly good and efficient condition to the entire satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors.

I note that your Superintendent Engineer has been in touch with the Society's Office at your Port regarding the case, but may say that no report has yet come to hand from the Hull Surveyors of any examination having been made by them on the vessel, but I am communicating with them in regard to the matter.

I think it well at the same time to add that until the Special Survey for re-classification has been completed and the Surveyors' report ^{has} received the Committee's consideration it will not be possible to re-insert the vessel's ^{original} classification in the Register Book.
