With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of your steamer "LORD STALBRIDGE", I beg to remind you that the screw shafts of this vessel have not been drawn in for examination by the Society's Surveyors since she was built in November, 1909, and as the Society's Rules require this to be done at intervals of not more than two years I shall be obliged if you will kindly let me know for the information of the Committee when and at what port you propose complying with this requirement.

At the same time I beg to acquaint you that the Special Survey No.1 prescribed by the Society's Rules became due on this vessel at the end of last month and I shall also be glad to learn your intentions in regard to this inspection.

I enclose for your information an abstract from the Rules describing the requirements of this Survey together with a list of the ports at which Surveyors to this Society are stationed.
