With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the Motorship "MALIA", I beg to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Greenock have been informed by Messrs. T. & J. Brocklebank, Ltd. that this vessel has been acquired by your goodselves, and that it is not proposed to proceed further with the Special Survey No. 1 which became due in September 1925, it being understood that you intend to transfer the classification of the vessel to another Register.

In the circumstances, the Classification Committee, who had the case before them at their Meeting yesterday, decided to recommend to the General Committee at their Meeting tomorrow, that the class be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
