

T.S. MOTOR VESSEL "MALIA".

The propelling machinery of this vessel consists of two sets of "Cammellaird Fullagar" Oil Engines.

The port engine was made under Special Survey in 1920 and was originally fitted in the M.S. "Fullagar"; it has been opened out and examined and overhauled under the supervision of the Liverpool Surveyors.

The Starboard engine has now been constructed under Special Survey and the whole of the machinery has been fitted on board and satisfactorily tried under working conditions.
