Yamahoko Maru, due to tidal current on the 14th December 1940 at a Port.

RECOMMENDATIONS.

One docking bridge deck stanchion, (channel bar) at stern bent.

To be removed, faired and refitted.

Top end bracket and deck attaching angle of the stanchion bent.

Bracket to be removed, faired & refitted, and deck attaching angle to be faired in place.

Bottom end bracket of the stanchion slightly bent.

To be faired in place.

6 hand rail bars in way of the stanchion bent.

To be repaired as necessary.

Shank & stock of keedge anchor which was fastened the stanchion slightly bent.

Anchor to be removed, repaired and replaced.

It was further recommended that all removals necessary to effect repairs be replaced in good order and disturbed work be recoated as necessary.

The foregoing recommendations were made in order to place the vessel in as good a condition as before the damage was sustained and have now satisfactorily been completed.
