With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the Motor Hopper Barge "MARY SOUTHWELL", which is understood to have recently become your property, I have to acquaint you that the vessel, which was built in June 1937 and classed "A - Hopper Barge, For Harbour Service", has not been submitted to Special Survey as required by the Society's Rules since that date, but that her class has been maintained by Annual General Examinations. I enclose a print setting forth a recent decision of the Committee in regard to periodical surveys, from which you will observe that the vessel should now be submitted to Special Survey and it will be appreciated if you will kindly let me know what arrangements you propose making in this connection.
